# PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

### Knowing all the facts before making a commitment

The Birkenhead RSA needs a new roof. The current roof is past it's lifespan by many years. The purpose of forming a sub-committee is to determine a path forward that will create a funding base for a new roof over the full complex in Recreation Drive, Birkenhead.

Given the current financial climate and the spend thrift nature of both society as a whole, and our membership, the committee will be tasked with the raising of funds that will be either be sufficient within a nominated time span to commission a new roof or in consultation with the Executive and Management, support a long lasting temporary solution.



# HOW MUCH DO WE NEED

The cost of a complete new roof has yet to be determined\*

Reroofing is not a simple matter of stripping off the old and replacing it with a new roof due to the complexities of working with asbestos. The companies capable of removing the current roof are reticent in giving a cost when we as an organisation cannot commit to a start date given our lack of funding.

The RSA also needs to look at alternative solutions that will give the building sufficient coverage for say, the next 10-15 years.

There are other forms of finance for such a capital hungry project and Management, the Executive and members will have the chance to comment on these options in due course.

Time is not on our side for any of the chosen options and that is why it is critical that the Executive puts together a body of capable members to move this project forward.

\*It is perceived that the cost will be in excess of \$400,000 for a new roof.

OR \*\$120,000 for s specialist paint system plus building repairs.

The Roofing Fund Sub Committee will raise the funding by way of annual targets.

### SUB COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

### Formation of the roof fundraising sub committee

The sub committee, herein called the Birkenhead RSA-RFS and for the purpose of the information and structure to follow, it will be referred to as the RFS.

# The Birkenhead RSA-RFS will be chaired by a Vice President as nominated by the President.

#### The Sub Committee will consist of:

- 1. The Chairperson nominated by the President.
- 2. One member of the Executive Committee, selected by the Chairperson and not allocated to other large projects within the RSA.
- 3. Six non Executive volunteers. Selected by the Chairperson. Volunteers must have knowledge, time and a great deal of commitment to a project that will pass through various Chairpersons via Annual Elections (AGM) of the Executive.
- 4. A side panel of professionally skilled advisors who voluntarily support the RFS with both technical skills and applications, liaising directly with the Chairperson. This includes online marketing via Facebook, graphic design work, AI specialists, Videographers.
- 5. An administration team nominated from outside the current management structure.
- 6. A qualified accountant/book keeper to keep account of income and expenditure. A separate bank account has been set up specifically for fundraising and donations.

### **CAUTION**

Volunteers on Birkenhead RSA-RFS will be challenged often and our message must be cohesive and firm.

# ROOF FUNDRAISING SUB COMMITTEE (RFS)

# THE RSA-RFS

### **Forming the Fund Raising Sub Committee**

The RFS will meet monthly in the upper conference room of the Birkenhead RSA.

The RFC will be looking for a treasurer. The treasurers duties will defined later but in the main the treasurer will produce a monthly report at RFS meetings showing the sponsors, sponsorship monies received plus outgoings approved by the RFS committee, or the President. Various other responsibilities are envisioned.

The Chairperson will call for nominations for vice chairperson. All positions remain fluid including those of the Chairperson and the executive member.

The second Vice President of the Birkenhead RSA has the right to sit in on all meetings of RFS and is encouraged to do so for continuity.

**Responsibility:** This RFS committee will be responsible for the selection of, and the coordination of, all approved fundraising initiatives for the re-roofing/refurbishment of the Birkenhead RSA roof. As much as there will be guidelines to work within, this is not a Management project. It falls to the Executive and the RFS to manage and grow the funding pool. The buck stops with the Fundraising Sub Committee, with full support of the Executive, and relies entirely on volunteer support from within.

The fundraising will be assessed and graded. No matter how large or small the effort, everything will have the Birkenhead RSA logo evident. The committee must ensure the protection of the goodwill of the RSA in the eyes of the public from whom it will be seeking support.

It will be incumbent on each member of RFS to receive suggestions for fundraising from a members and to work with that member to break the ideas down, assess the idea for merit and present the idea to the Committee at the next meeting of the RFS. Do not decide whether an idea is suitable. Refer it to RFS at the next monthly meeting. Give respect to the contributor and let the Committee decide.

We at RFS pledge to keep all members onside and remember our core objective is raising the funds to ensure the facility is warm and dry for the next 30 years for our Veterans and Associates.

Act in Good Faith with your members, your club and everyone that you talk to regarding our fundraising. Keep the message consistent positive at all times.



# **SPONSORSHIP**

### The Big Promotors

Without a doubt Sponsors and sponsorships will be the backbone of this fundraising drive. Given the right signals and seeing a solid effort from the Birkenhead RSA Executive and members, sponsors can be encouraged to give generously.

Our cause is our Veterans and the continued provision of a safe harbour for both they, and all members of the Birkenhead RSA to congregate, commemorate and celebrate times gone by and issues ahead.

Sponsorship is a mega business. We see it in every area of our lives, including within our club/association. Sponsors look to expand their name and service through the gifting of funds that help individuals and teams to excel at their chosen activity. This sponsorship generally comes with a reciprocal request from the benefactor and so often it is the large signage and banners that we see over buildings and billboards as well as promotional material.

The Birkenhead RSA's existence, in essence creates a sort of duality, preserving our individuality amid public scrutiny. In effect, people know the RSA exists but they do not know us, the essence of our camaraderie and why we prefer our club over the many alternative social establishments. #### **Action Plan:**

- 1. Make a list of 50 large companies and fifty individuals that we will approach in the first wave of activity.
- 2. Create a letter for mailout/email asking for support. This will be short and sharp in the first wave of activity and a precursor to the phone calls that we will make to secure appointments to present our case formally.
- 3. Write a sponsorship document or formal brochure to support our drive.

NB: If you have solid experience in this field then I want to meet you!

Sponsors may need visible recognition for their contribution. The RFS will formulate appropriate forms of recognition for the various amounts that are received into our re roofing account. The Club sees an honours style board as appropriate to the limited space available within the RSA.

- 9. Veterans only cocktails and dinner.



### **DUTIES OF CHAIRPERSON**

This is a general list of duties and responsibilities only.
This will Change as the RFS committee beds in.

### Chairperson

Responsible to the President for the general maintenance and management of the drive for funding for the replacement/refurbishment of Birkenhead RSA roof.

- 1. Chair monthly meeting of the Roof Fundraising Committee (RFS)
- 2. Allocate positions of the sub committee when there is a need for personnel change.
- 3. Approve minor payments from the FRS account to cover costs of implementing approved fund raising activities.
- 4. Approve the current funding statement from the monthly RFS meeting and present this to the Executive at the monthly meeting of the Executive.
- 5. Approve all letters and communications that are sent out to potential contributors.
  - 6. Answer all queries from the Birkenhead RSA President and RSA Manager.
- 7. Arrange for the upkeep of the contribution board showing current status of fundraising.
  - 8. Meet with sponsors to promote the fund raising drive.
  - 9. Answer all questions related to the RFS and it's activities.
- 10. Adjust monthly Targets to keep the fundraising effort relevant and ahead of increasing costs.
- 11. Support approved funding activities by being physically visible along its execution.
  - 12. Report status of the fund to members at the AGM



It is integral for the RFS to remain and retain it's members even through changes to the Executive via Annual or Emergency General Meetings. The Chair must be a Vice President or both Vice Presidents but the President retains the right to appoint the Chairperson best suited the demands at a given period of time.

All appointees to the RFS must be fully paid up RSA members.





# GUIDE FOR RFS COMMITTEE

### Duty of Care to those that wish to participate

Appointed members to any or all committees must have a fair idea of what will be required of them. The RFS is not a sit down job. Without the commitment to physical activity in support of initiatives that are running hot and strong the fire will go out quickly. When this happens the remaining members can be left high and dry and the initiative will fail.

#### **Appointed RFS Member**

- 1. Attend all monthly meetings of the Roof Fundraising Sub Committee.
- 2. Present all initiatives that have been received from club members including a report on how the initiative will operate and what personnel may be involved.
- 3. Hear initiatives at committee and discuss the merits in an open and transparent way that allows for quick decisions and outcomes.
- 4. Will be appointed to various initiatives and may be given a leadership role in initiatives as skill levels become evident. Be an active participant throughout the tenure of RFS.
- 5. Will be able to respond to questions from Club members. This requires quiet purpose and patience. Every initiative will have detractors.
- 6. Be available via online communications and preferably have a home printer.
- 7. Keep all communication within the RFS committee. The Chair is Lead.

NB: A template is available to members who have ideas and wish to submit their ideas openly or anonymously.

Keep a high level of enthusiasm to the task at hand. There will be periods when the RFS does not achieve, relevant to effort. However, that effort will be your reward further down by keeping the faith.

- 11. The RSA has a full year of **music and dance**, all programmed to allow members to have that ever portant time out from a gadget driven society and dance the nights away. Few venues exist today that provide this activity.
- 12. **Hall Hire:** The clubrooms have spaces that can be hired out to members and the community as a whole to host their own functions and activities.
- 13. The Birkenhead RSA supports the **catering contractor** to the club, providing excellent cooking facilities from which to serve our members and friends.
- 14. The **volunteer driver pool** is essential for getting our ailing members to their hospital or specialist appointments across Auckland. The Birkenhead RSA is actively seeking sponsors for replacement vehicle (or two) and would like to talk to anyone that can help in this regard. We are not seeking new vehicles.
- 15. The Birkenhead RSA has a **formal management structure supported by a Governance committee.** Total volunteer hours would exceed the total staff hours by at least 4 times. This is our personal commitment to the ongoing success of the club to members, young and old.
